HMS will be paid on a contingency basis, meaning that for every dollar in audit adjustments reported, they will keep a percentage as their fee. With this type of aggressive auditing, compliance is more essential than ever.

A detailed presentation of how Connecticut will handle the new RAC process will be explained, and providers will have their questions answered and concerns heard by both HMS and DSS. If your agency has never been through a DSS audit, we strongly suggest that you attend this informative meeting as an increasing amount of programs and organizations may now be selected for audit by the Medicaid RACs.
