CCPA Membership Categories:

Organizational Member:

Organizations which provide community based programs, supports and services for children and adults in areas including, but not limited to: mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance use disorders.

Associate Member:

Organizations that support the objectives of the Association but are not eligible for organizational membership, including state and national voluntary organizations, governmental agency administrative offices, Independent Living Centers, and university training programs.

Individual Member:

Individuals who support the work of the Association but are not eligible for membership in another category. A person employed by an organization eligible for organizational membership is not eligible to join as an individual member.

Sustaining Member:

Individuals or organizations that wish to provide special support to the Association that are not eligible for membership as Organizational members. This may include corporations, professional firms, commercial vendors and consulting firms.
