Statement from Jeffrey Walter, Interim CEO of CT Community Nonprofit Alliance, on the budget passed tonight:

"On behalf of more than a half million individuals across the state who rely on community-based services, we thank the House and Senate for supporting the FY17 budget. These are difficult budget times and this spending plan makes painful cuts. But it could be much worse, and does include funding to allow many programs to continue to provide life-sustaining services to some of the state's most at-risk individuals and contribute to the overall quality of life in our state.

"As they implement this difficult spending plan in the coming months, we ask that the Administration and agencies be open and forthright with community providers, and that they consider nonprofit community-based programs to be part of the solution to how the state can continue to provide quality services."
